UNICEF is a program that focused on IDD last year. In Africa, Iodine Deficiency Disorder is a huge problem. Raising money was the main way to help out with project UNICEF. This year, they have slightly changed their viewpoint to include a new program called Kicking HIV/AIDS out of Kenya. This year's United States goal of \$500,000 will be sent to help with the soccer program of Kicking HIV/AIDS out of Kenya. This soccer program is one that will teach kids in Kenya life skills, promote leadership, and strengthen decision making skills and raise awareness about HIV/AIDS.

Key Club members are asked to participate by Trick-or-Treating for UNICEF. At unicef.org you can get the UNICEF boxes that are used for the collection of loose change. Get together club members, or maybe pull in the local children soccer team, and go to houses or local businesses in your community, asking if they would donate any spare change they have to promote UNICEF.

The change that you collect and send in will go to UNICEF Kenya, give the project content, equipment, and project support that is needed to sustain the soccer program. The funds will also provide Kenya children with food, clothing, and school material.

The best part, is that for the 2006 year, Key Clubs are eligible to participate in the Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF Challenge. If your club raises the most money of any group participating, the UNICEF sponsor, Procter & Gamble, will donate \$125,000 to UNICEF on behalf of your school! Let's make everything clear on what is required in your Reporter Reports, reporters.

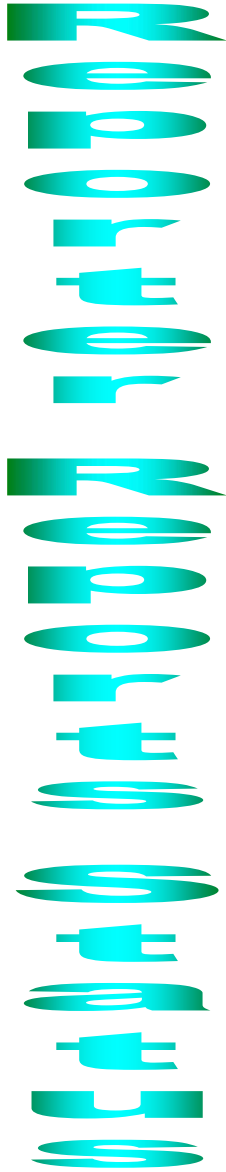
Your reports are due on the 10th in the months of January, March, May, July, September, and November. In your Reports you must explain a major project your club has done in the past two months (since the last report).
